SPECTATORS INFORMATION



Gymnasts and Competition Officials

Those who are entered and competing or thoses who are judging are not required to purchase a ticket.

Spectator Ticket Fee

The venue holds a seating allocation of 300 spaces.

- £5 per Adult,
- £2 per Child and
- £12.00 per Family above 3 individuals.

This will be collected at the allocated door entry by a member of the competition team.

We can now accept card payments on the day as well as cash.

MEDIA INFORMATION

Our events team will be taking photographs through out the day for posting on social media. Whilst efforts will be made across the day to respect everyones privacy preferences, it may not be possible to accommodate everyones preferences.

Spectators will be able to take photography or film, these can not be sold for commercial use and must not use flash photography at any IGA event. There will be a resident professional photography on site to take stills for purchase.

COACHES ACCREDITATION & GYMNASTS

Coaches must have current Membership with their governing body and qualified at least to Level 2. It is the responsibility of the club and the coach to ensure appropriate training has been completed by the nominated coach.

Code of Conduct

No breach of the rules, policies or codes of conduct that apply either generally or specifically to the event.

The rules of all events include requirements that clubs and participants will:

- Display high personal standards and a favourable image that is befitting to the role in the sport
- Not endanger the reputation of this event or governing body through inappropriate practices or behaviour
- Display moderate and responsible behaviour at all times
- Be polite courteous and respectful to others
- Use their knowledge as objectively as possible and maintain a scrupulous fairness in their dealings with others.
- Endeavour to dissipate inflammatory situations
- Ensure that differences of opinion or conflicts are dealt with through the proper processes
- Do not abuse, harass, bully or victimise others.
- Will not coach their gymnasts during a routine.

Gymnasts eligibility

All events are for recreational gymnastics levels therefore the gymnast should not be training more than 4 hours per week

HEALTH AND SAFETY



We kindly request that all coaches and gymnasts arrive on time, register and go straight to warm up.



Equipment Safety

All equipment will be set up by the leisure centre. It will be checked by our competition organiser and officials before the event commences.

First Aider & Welfare Officer

First Aiders will be provided by the leisure centre staff. Any first aid required must be reported in to the events team.

WITHDRAWALS, EVENT TIMINGS, SCORES AND RESULTS

Withdrawals - gymnasts with a line through their name or highlighted blue have withdrawn from the event. There will be no refunds for withdrawals.

The final running order will be posted to the clubs ASAP after the closing date.

The results and scores if requested can be emailed. although in general not usually requested as its a recreational event.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All coaches and gymnasts must be covered through relevant governing body insurance.
- MOURNE GYMNASTICS.com
- The event host (Banbridge Leisure Centre) will provide all apparatus required; however teams are able to bring their own mini trampettes for team gym event providing it meets thesafety requirements and is available for other teams to use.
- If you are bringing your own trampette you must notify the event organiser at the time of entering.
- Set-up of equipment (and safety of equipment) is the responsibility of the event host Banbridge Leisure Centre.
- Coaches may approach the Floor Manager or Head Judge at the event if they do not consider the set-up to be adequate.
- All ages are taken as of on the day of the competition.
- Safety is held in the utmost importance. The choice of skills and composition of routines must never allow difficulty to take preference over technique. The performance should always be suitable to the ability level of each team member.
- Floor Area this is a non-sprung floor.
- The Give It A Go All Competitions have a full floor area of 10m x 12 m.
- The Wind N Wacky has five 12 x 2 floor strips.
- The Junior and Derek Clark Competition has five 12 x 2 floor strips.
- All equipment is provided by Banbridge Leisure Centre and is under their repair and maintenance regime.

GENERIC WARM-UP

Pulse raiser and stretches will be completed in an allocated area of the floor

WARM UP INFORMATION

Floor orientation - dependant on group size up to 10 min floor orientation

Vault - dependant on group size up to 10 min apparatus orientation

Beam - dependant on group size up to 10 min Beam orientation - skill practice only

Bars - dependant on group size up to 10 min Bars orientation

Tumbling - dependant on group size up to 10 min floor / apparatus orientation

ENDORSEMENT

All of our events have been endorsed by Independant Gymnastics Association IGA







Clubs are expected to provide judges. No Judge No Entry.

If you are entering up to 15 gymnasts you must provide a minimum of one Judge.

If you are entering 16+ Gymnasts you must provide minimum 2 Judges.

The event organisers will place Judges where they request or are best suited due to level of qualification.

Judges must be qualified and have some judging experience.

Trainee Judges will rarely be left un attended. Unless there are extenuating circumstances.
